— Championship awards points toward the Purina Top Shooting Dog Award & Purina Handler of the Year Award —

Entry Fee: \$210.00 + \$40.00 grounds fee • Purse: 60% of entry fees divided 65–35

Qualification: A placement in a recognized Open Shooting Dog or Open Derby stake.
