Remembering Betty Eaton & Buddy Smith

With the death of two great people, very dear friends, July became a sad time for this scribe. Betty Eaton, wife of Hall of Fame professional Hoyle Eaton, died July 5, and Buddy Smith passed a few weeks later, and I had to face the loss of two of the finest people I have ever had years of association with. I met Hoyle Eaton on the prairies of Canada in 1964, and my career as an American Field trial reporter brought me in contact with him often on the circuit of major trials. I met Betty after the Southwestern Championship, then in Booneville, Arkansas. Hoyle and Tommy Olive invited me to ride with them from Booneville, Arkansas, to Booneville, Mississippi, in the big red dog truck, along with the horses and Hoyle's string of bird dogs, including Riggins White Knight and Red Water Rex. In a crowded truck cab, I was responsible for changing gears. I stayed with Hoyle and Betty for nearly a week, and besides cooking great meals, Betty would ask me whether I needed any clothes washed or repaired, or whether she could shop in town for anything I needed. Betty worked in Booneville, and this reporter had no vehicle. A fine lady looking after me. I was there a week, then we departed for the Quail

Championship Invitational at Paducah, Kentucky. It was a time when Betty and Hoyle's sons Joe and Paul were youngsters.

A few years later, I was nominated and elected to the Board of Directors of the Bird Dog Foundation. I conversed with Hoyle and Betty, who attended the Grand Junction Hall of Fame presentations and the accompanying banquet and party. They invited me to stay with them during my Bird Dog Foundation attendance, and for 20 years each February, I got to know Hoyle and Betty in depth. Many times, while driving to their home on Friday, I would call and ask what we were doing for dinner that evening. Would fish be suitable? The best takeout fish-and-chips dinner I have ever found was available right on my way to the Eaton home in Jumpertown, and I brought the outstanding feast to the evening dinner table.

Betty was very active in her church, mostly on the musical side of things, mainly the choir, which she managed. Hoyle read the bible every night before retiring. Betty would be the first to go to bed, then I would make my move, and I never left for my bedroom without noticing Hoyle was still reading his bible.

A phone call from Clarice, Buddy Smith's wonderful wife, apprised me of Buddy's passing, only an hour or two after it happened. Although Buddy and I were both 91, I wanted the two of us to go on with dogs and field trials and be great friends, doing things together for a few more years. It was not to be, but we did have our February visitations. With the death of Hoyle Eaton, I was invited to stay at the Smith residence in Collierville during my stay at the Bird Dog Foundation events, the Hall of Fame inductions, and the Board Meeting. We always visited the Brittany group on Friday evening to attend their get-together party at their Collierville motel, only a few blocks from Buddy's home.

I met Buddy Smith at a field trial. I think it was an NBHA event, but the stakes were of the walking handler variety. He also ran dogs in Horseback Shooting Dog stakes. Buddy's influence on the pointing dog world was far greater than his accolades as a dog trainer and field trial handler. He was extremely successful as a breeder, trainer, and developer of nationally known bird dogs.

Very notable were Buddy's skills in breeding, selection of bloodlines, and recognizing the talents of dogs for use in breeding programs. He bred and trained Shadow Oak Bo up to his Derby year, and Bo was broke to perfection and ready for an owner. Butch Houston, Dr. John Dorminy, and Robin Gates took Bo forward. Bo won the National Championship two successive years, 2013 and 2014.

Buddy was also involved in the breeding and early training of dogs such as Lehar's Main Tech, winner of eight championships including the three-hour Free-For-All, plus the same story on House's Rain Cloud who won five Open championships and six runner-up titles, the Quail Championship Invitational three times and had a total of 37 field trial wins. Cedaroak Kate, who won the National Championship handled by owner Tommy Honecker, was bred and trained by Buddy. More champions include dogs such as Warhoot Rogue and Admiral War Bond. The above are horseback dogs, but to show his versatility, in 1987 Buddy's dogs won 80 placements in horseback and walking trials, and 70 the following year, setting a record.

One facet of Buddy's training was his brainstorm in creating the "Buddy Stick." It is a 10-foot section of a 1-inch-diameter wooden stake with a snap on the end. I found it invaluable for a lone amateur dog breaker with a dog on point on a planted bird, using only a check cord, trying to get in front of that pointing dog to flush the bird. With the Buddy Stick gentle prods and a few

"whoas," one could get totally in front and keep that dog in place, flush the bird, and keep the dog steady to wing. What a help this was to this scribe.

Buddy's talents and accomplishments have not gone unnoticed by the field trial world. He has been inducted into three Halls of Fame, has conducted many dog training and handling seminars, and has judged a host of field trials. He won the first NBHA Futurity in 1986, and also the American Field Quail and Pheasant Futurities. He has won NBHA Handler of the Year awards.

I sincerely miss my time with Buddy Smith, but my mind harks back to all he has contributed to the bird dog sport. His was certainly an outstanding career with bird dogs. 🐾

That mission remains as important as ever. But how we deliver that information continues to evolve.

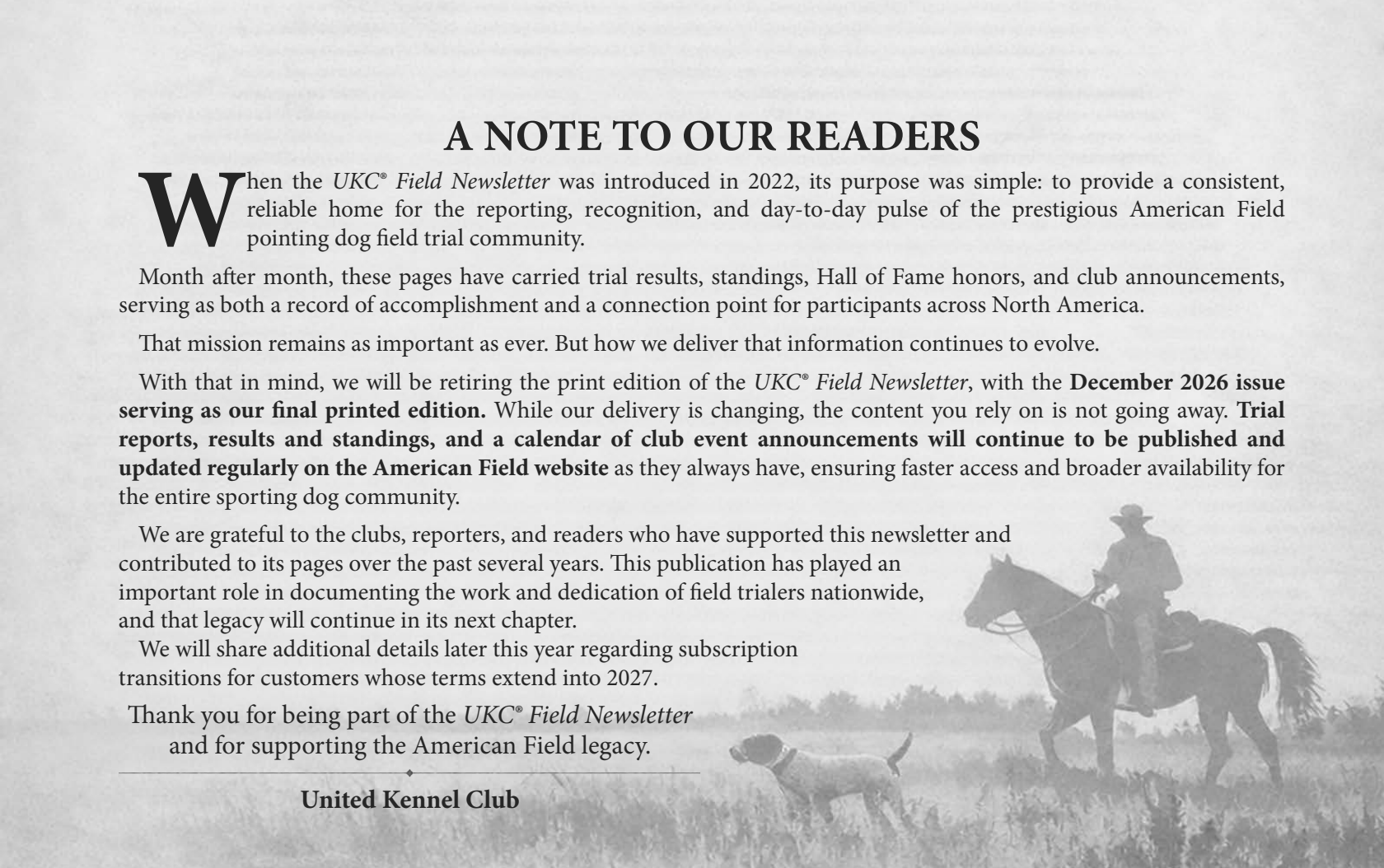

UKC SANCTIONS

— A Guide for American Field Participants —

American Field and *Field Dog Stud Book* have an excellent reputation for handling the infrequent cases of misconduct that have surfaced throughout the history of the registry and the sport of field trialing. Over the years, customers of American Field have become familiar with the company's terms and conditions for handling such situations. As United Kennel Club endeavors to merge the two business models into one, it is apparent we need to clarify some terms that American Field customers may be seeing regarding UKC sanctions as we move forward. We have a clear responsibility to communicate the consequences of failing to abide by the rules, requirements, and expected standards of our sport. Clubs hosting events are fully accountable for addressing and resolving issues that arise during those events and serve as the first and primary point of resolution. To keep their events in good standing, clubs are required to report the incident—and its resolution—for final review by the UKC. Upon review, if warranted, the UKC may take additional appropriate action.

All participants are entitled to know the potential consequences and how they are defined. The first term we must address is that of UKC's Inherent Rights and Powers. The policy, in its entirety, is lengthy, but to summarize, it basically says that UKC has the right to make all final decisions regarding sanctions pertaining to misconduct. While we strive to make sure levels of due process are adhered to along the way, UKC's Inherent Rights and Powers gives UKC the right to take any action it deems appropriate even if there was a bobble in a hearing process along the way. A minor technicality during any part of the misconduct procedures will not get a case thrown out or prevent UKC from taking appropriate action.

The primary term referencing sanctions in the recent history of American Field was called a "Loss of Privileges." Loss of privileges may span as short a term as six months to a term that included many years. While UKC does have a sanction similar to this, we also have additional levels of sanctions that you may see moving forward.

Since our acquisition of the American Field, the UKC has acted on formal complaints, resulting in warnings and probationary terms. Although the UKC would far and away prefer only to promote our sport, recognize wins, provide registrations, report events, and congratulate accomplishments, we will not hesitate to take the necessary oversight actions to protect the integrity of our sport for all to enjoy.

LEVELS OF UKC SANCTIONS

1



WARNING

Our first level of sanction could be referred to as a strongly worded letter of warning. A warning letter is issued to let an individual know that the conduct they were accused of will not be tolerated by UKC. Such a letter creates a case file for a person, which may prove beneficial to the registry in the event that an individual is accused of wrongdoing in the future. A letter of warning does not expire.

2



PROBATION

The second level of sanction is referred to as Probation. A term of probation is typically issued for a period of six months to three years. A term of probation does not result in loss of registration or event privileges. It does create a case file for an individual, with the understanding that any other act of misconduct during the probationary period will automatically result in suspension from registering dogs and from participating in licensed events.

SUSPENSION

The third level of sanction at UKC is called Suspension. A suspension does result in the loss of registry and event privileges. A suspension term will typically be classified as six months, one year, or indefinite. A suspension term automatically includes a period of three years of probation at the completion of the suspension term. It is not unusual for a person serving an indefinite suspension to be reinstated at some point. This would be handled on a case-by-case basis.

BARRED

The final level of sanction is referred to as Barred and typically carries with it a term of life. It is rarely necessary to bar someone permanently, but it may be necessary for an act so egregious as to be unforgivable, or when an individual commits an act worthy of suspension while already serving a suspension.

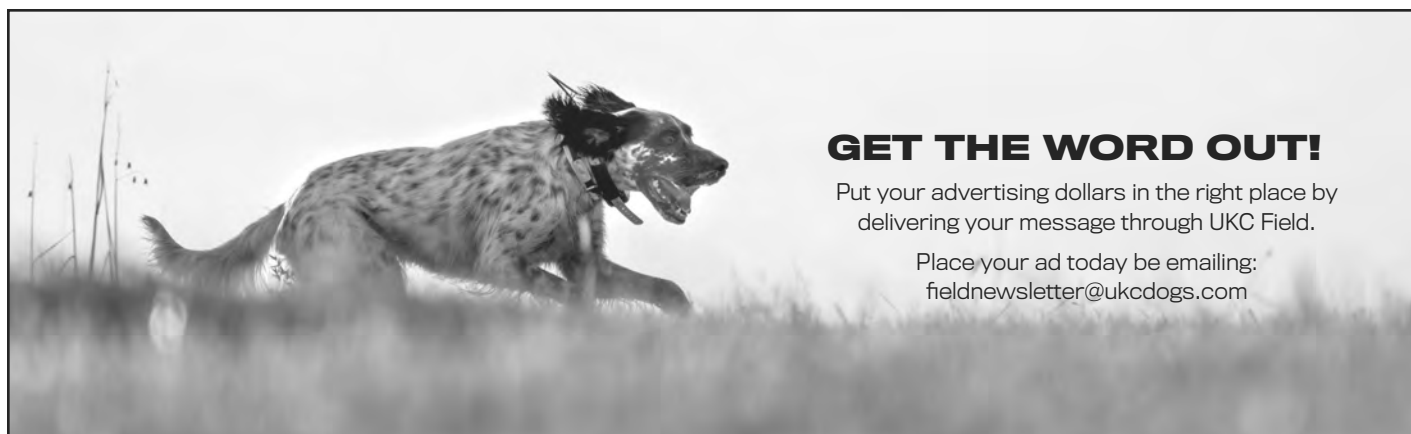

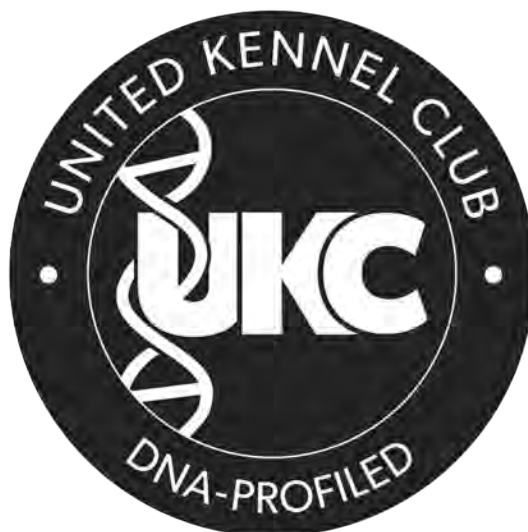

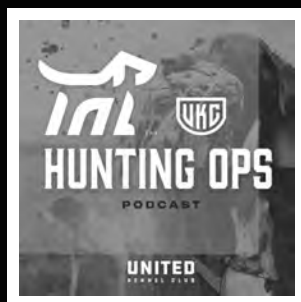
